

Dean of Student Life

Description: The Dean of Student Life reports directly to the Vice President of Student Affairs. S/he is responsible for the overall vision and effectiveness of Stillman's student services and will supervise a part-time, Director of Student Activities. The Dean of Students is responsible for developing and overseeing programs that enable students to realize their fullest intellectual and personal potential, and for integrating student life experiences with the College's educational mission. By working with and representing the interests of a diverse student body, the Dean ensures a mutually reinforcing relationship between the academic and non-academic areas of the College.

The Dean plays a central role in defining the strong sense of community that unites students, faculty, and staff across differences of racial and ethnic background, gender, class, and educational background. The Dean is centrally involved in formulating college policy, including budget allocation and long-range planning, and is the campus liaison with the Student Activities Board.

Role & Responsibilities: The Dean of Student Life will monitor and manage the Student Government Association, other student organizations, and facilitate Stillman students' participation with the University of Alabama, Shelton State University, and community organizations in Tuscaloosa. The Dean will direct and manage community service hours and work closely with Enrollment Management, Athletics, Career Services, and Academic Affairs to facilitate a comprehensive activity and learning environment.

Qualifications: Master's degree with 2 years of experience working with students on a college campus.
