

## **Visiting Professor**

**Duties:** The Visiting Professor is a non-tenure track position held by an individual who possesses all the qualifications to be appointed at that rank or who has held that rank at another institution. The Visiting Professor's teaching responsibilities are assigned by the academic department head and may include serving as an academic advisor. The Visiting Professor may teach part-time or full-time based on the needs of the department; and is also eligible to conduct research as a Principal Investigator and/or Project Director on sponsored projects. The Visiting Professor may teach face-to-face or online instruction. The Visiting Professor receives administrative supervision from the Department Head and may exercise supervision of graduate assistants, undergraduate majors, or student employees.

### **Education and Experience:**

Master's degree required with 2 to 3 years of teaching experience in an institution of higher education. Experience with managing staff and students and collaboration with faculty and administrative staff. Doctoral degree preferred.
